

Harvest Share Program: Home Delivery

Here you can find all the information you'll need to be a member of Everdale's Harvest Share program. 2020 is Everdale's 22nd year in running the Harvest Share! Thanks to all of our members for your support!

What it means to be a member:

- Regular deliveries within our area (see map link below)
- Pre-packed boxes that match your preferences
- You choose how many deliveries you would like to receive
- You choose a share size to suit your needs
- Supporting Everdale's goal of eliminating food insecurity in Wellington County
 - NEW IN 2020
 - We have been and will continue to bring in organic imported fruits and vegetables to round out selection (our priority will still be local).
 - High protein products like eggs, cheese and milk.
 - Other staples like bread from Polestar and coffee from Planet Bean (both in Guelph)
 - Pick-up location for Heartwood Cider and Goodlot Beer
 - Access to our Ontario Natural Food Company buying club



In order to qualify for home delivery, you must fall within our delivery zone. <u>Click here</u> to see the map.

What you'll receive

After your register, you'll have the opportunity to fill out a short survey letting us know your preferences. We'll tailor a box to suit your needs. If at any point you'd like to change your preferences, just let us know!



Share Sizes (recommendations in the FAQ's on our website)

- Small (24 points): Cost per pick-up: \$35.84
- Medium (36 points): Cost per pick-up: \$49.76
- Large (54 points): Cost per pick-up: \$70.64
- Extra-Large (72 points): Cost per pick-up: \$91.52

Choosing the number of deliveries to receive Please choose how many deliveries you will be receive carefully. If you miss more deliveries than you had planned, it is not possible to "double up" or "carry over" those deliveries.

Example: If you sign up for 25 out of the 42 deliveries, you may choose any 25. Simply send us an email by Monday at midnight to skip that **week's delivery.** If you pay for 25 but only choose to have 23 delivered, then two deliveries worth of your share will be donated to a local organization.

We will keep track of how many deliveries you've received and let you know as you get close to running out.





Determining your payment

This registration period of the Harvest Share will take place from May 2020 to May of 2021. A total of 42 possible deliveries. Members can sign up for <u>as few as 23</u> of these. If you sign up for less than the full 42, you can use your deliveries whenever you choose, just let us know by Monday at midnight if you would like to skip that **week's delivery**.

If you sign up for between 23 and 29 deliveries, you can pay in full or by three installments (please provide three cheques – a deposit upon registration, one dated July 15th, 2020 and one dated Sept. 15th, 2020 each for 1/3 of your total).

If you sign up for between 30 and the full 42 deliveries, you can pay in full, by three installments, or monthly. To calculate a monthly payment: Cost per delivery X Number deliveries (between 30-42) and divide by 12 Example: A small share (\$35.84/delivery) X 35 deliveries divided by 12 equal monthly payments would cost \$104.53/month

Cancellation Policy

We understand that life circumstances sometimes change and that the Harvest Share program is a big commitment. If something comes up and you are no longer able to participate in the share please let us know right away. Everdale will refund you for any deliveries you haven't attended from the date you let us know forward, but we cannot refund for missed deliveries prior to the date you let us know. An administration fee of 5% of your total share cost will be deducted if you do decide to cancel.

Where your share comes from

One of Everdale's missions is to support a vibrant local food system. For this reason, we provide fruit, vegetables and other items from

other farms and distributors as part of the share. It also allows us to provide more variety than we could provide on our own. We will always prioritize the sourcing of produce from as locally as possible but will buy from other countries to round out the selection.
